ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for community clinic help, you must be a constituent of London-Fanshawe and be earning a modest income and have a simple tax situation.

In general, a modest income means your total family income is less than \$35,000 a year for an individual or \$45,000 for a couple/household (plus \$5000 for the first dependent and \$2500 for each additional dependent).

Other local community organizations may set different amounts. Please contact them directly for more information.

A simple tax situation means that you have no income or if your income comes from any of these sources: employment pension benefits such as the CPP, disability insurance, EI, and social assistance registered retirement savings plans (RRSPs) support payments scholarships, fellowships, bursaries or grants interest (under \$1,000) Free tax clinics will not provide services if you (more complicated): are self-employed or have employment expenses INCLUDING ANY RENTAL INCOME have business or rental income and expenses

have capital gains or losses

are an International student

filed for bankruptcy in the tax year (or the year before, if that return has not yet been filed)

are completing a tax return for a deceased person.
